The Point-in-Time (PIT) count is an annual nation wide event required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the State of Washington Department of Commerce that counts the number of individuals experiencing homeless in every state. The results from the PIT are reported to create a trend analysis in the mission to end homelessness in America.
