Engrossed Second Substitute Senate Bill 5444

An ACT relating to providing timely competency evaluations and restoration services.

- Signed into law May 9, 2019
- Goes into effect July 28, 2019
- Amends RCW 10.31.110, 10.77.086, and 10.77.088
- Adds new section to Chapter 10.77 RCW

Chapter 10.77 – new Section 2

- Creates Forensic Navigators
- Outlines non-clinical designation & duties
- Immune from civil liability
- Access to all records



RCW 10.31.110

Expands eligible crimes where diversion can be employed

- Encourages use of diversion
- Requires law enforcement to continue using local diversion guidelines to inform decisionmaking

RCW 10.77.086

- Creates outpatient competency restoration in locations where resource is available
- Court decides based on input from parties and the forensic navigator
- Includes conditions of release
- Noncompliance can result in transfer to inpatient



RCW 10.77.088

For those charged with a nonfelony and found not competent:

- Designated crisis responder evaluates for detention proceedings under RCW 71.05 unless prosecutor objects.
- If objecting, prosecutor must prove compelling state interest for court to order restoration

HCA Funds

- Outpatient Competency Restoration
- Expanded Crisis services
 - Increased rates for crisis triage/stabilization
 - Mobile Crisis
 - Emergency vouchers
- Intensive Case Management (case finding, outreach, engagement)
- Enhanced continuing education curriculum for certified Peer Supports
- Housing supports through four additional Housing and Recovery through Peer Services (HARPS)
 - Housing subsidies
 - Supportive housing services
