Individuals and households affected by mandated closures and restrictions will make them become unstable and/or homeless in the coming months. The coming wave of households, who may enter into homelessness if safeguards are not put into place, will crash and decimate our homelessness and social services network.

Here at Shared Housing Services, we are formulating strategies today about how our services can be of help during the post COVID-19 recovery. We know there will be no one-size-fits-all for folks finding themselves unstably housed because of the pandemic. It is going to take herculean efforts by Local/State/Federal agencies, and community members themselves, to get through the difficult times ahead.

Shared Housing Services' Homesharing programs assist community members who are becoming unstable and/or housing insecure to stabilize by utilizing their extra bedroom(s) to remain in their homes. At the same time these extra bedrooms become safe, affordable housing options for those who may already be experiencing homelessness or have become unstable and do not have an extra bedroom to rent out. Having operated our Homesharing Model for nearly 29-years, we have the best practices and infrastructure already in place to immediately assist those needing help to stabilize in their home.
