## ORDER OF COUNCILORS WU AND MEJIA

ORDERED: That under the provisions of section 17F of Chapter 452 of the Acts of 1948, as

amended, and any other applicable provision of law, His Honor, the Mayor, be, and hereby is, requested to obtain and deliver to the City Council, within one week of the receipt hereof, the following information:

- A comprehensive breakdown of applicants and recipients by neighborhood or zip code, race, gender, income, and any other available demographic data for the Boston Resiliency Fund, Rental Relief Fund, Small Business Relief Fund, and Reopen Boston Fund.
- 2) List of sources of funding, including donors and amounts from the Boston Resiliency Fund, Rental Relief Fund, Small Business Relief Fund, and Reopen Boston Fund.
- Additionally for the Small Business Relief Fund and Reopen Boston Fund, information on industry, number of employees, and indicating which businesses have a designation of MWBE status for all applicants and recipients.
- 4) A description of outreach methods and timeline, including language access plans, used to promote and solicit applications for the relief funds listed above; the mechanism for disbursements so far; the list of organizations that have served as conduits for disbursement; and plans for future disbursements.
- 5) A comprehensive breakdown of all COVID-19 related contracts and applications, including the vendor name, description, amount, city department/agency, industry, and contract dates, as well as designation of MWBE and SLBE status.
