Eviction Defense

Most but not all tenants are covered by the State and Federal Eviction Moratoriums and by local ordinances. The State moratorium ends Oct. 15, 2020 and the Federal CDC moratorium ends Dec. 31, 2020.

We need to

keep as many people in housing that is safe and appropriate as possible. encourage people NOT to self-evict unless they are going to better housing keep track of self-evictions, of any "legal" evictions report landlords/property managers threatening tenants in any way. be sure tenants to know their rights. monitor use of all rental assistance funds, especially CARES Relief Funds

In a perfect world, some entity would be responsible for collecting and updating all of the eviction-related information with both resources and monitoring in one place - and maybe they are and I just don't know which one or where to go - but it seems to me that each provider, each funder, each jurisdiction posts their own information. This is what I know as of Sept. 10.
