Increasingly, political divisiveness impedes progress and lack of shelter has reached epidemic proportions in the richest country in the world.

Meanwhile, smaller scale ideas often benefit from non-partisan support. These ideas are sometimes hyper-local and can typically be quickly deployed to make a difference in the lives of people experiencing homelessness.
