RESOLUTION NO. 40677

A RESOLUTION relating to public health and safety; authorizing the execution of 1 an amendment to the agreement with Low Income Housing Institute, in the amount of \$2,241,616, budgeted from Emergency Solutions Grant 2 Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act funding, to expand temporary shelter bed capacity by developing and managing a temporary 3 emergency micro-shelter site, located at 6th Avenue and North Orchard Street, through June 30, 2023. 4 WHEREAS, in May 2017, the City declared a state of emergency around 5 homelessness to mitigate the impacts of unauthorized homeless encampments 6 7 in Tacoma, and to enable processes to guickly address the public health and safety risk encampments pose to those inhabiting them and the surrounding 8 community, and 9 WHEREAS the annual Point-in-Time Count conducted in January 2020 10 11 reported 544 homeless individuals in Tacoma, with 158 individuals unsheltered, 12 and WHEREAS this data shows that there is still a deficit in the number of 13 14 available shelter beds in Tacoma, and there are still individuals and families living 15 in situations that are not fit for human habitation, and 16 WHEREAS, in order to continue serving individuals experiencing 17 homelessness, the City proposes opening a new micro-shelter site at 602 North 18 Orchard Street which will provide 40 furnished micro-shelters, common areas, 19 case management, and other supportive services for individuals who are 20 currently experiencing homelessness, and 21 WHEREAS no more than 60 individuals will reside onsite at any time, and 22 will be limited to families with children, couples, and single women, and



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	WHEREAS, under the proposed amendment to the agreement with the	
1	Low Income Housing Institute ("LIHI"), LIHI will provide 24/7 on-site support and	
2	operations management for the micro-shelter site, and	
3	WHEREAS, as part of LIHI's standard operating model, a community	
4	advisory committee will be established to provide a community platform to	
5	discuss concerns, including safety and security, and	
6	WHEREAS the City Council will receive regular updates on the project's	
7	performance, and	
8	WHEREAS staff is recommending approval of the proposed amendment	
9	to the agreement with LIHI, in the amount of \$2,241,616, budgeted from	
10	Emergency Solutions Grant Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act	
11	funding, for this purpose; Now, Therefore,	
12	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:	
13	Section 1. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to	
14	enter into an amendment to the agreement with the Low Income Housing	
15	Institute, in the amount of \$2,241,616, budgeted from Emergency Solutions	
16	Grant Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act funding, to expand	
17	temporary shelter bed capacity by developing and managing a temporary	
18	emergency micro-shelter site, located at 6th Avenue and North Orchard Street	
19	through June 30, 2023, all as more specifically set forth in the proposed	
20	amendment on file in the office of the City Clerk.
