

Theme: Cultivating wonder and care by taking the bus to...

Eligibility: Open to K-12 students in Pierce County.

Submissions: Visual art created digitally or by hand, using pencils, crayons, paints,

or other medium.

Call for entries: October 1-31, 2020 **Requirements:** All submissions must be originally produced by the student and must adhere to Pierce Transit's Transit Advertising Policy. Literary art in the form of a poem or prose must not exceed 150 words. Photography submissions are prohibited.

Instructions: Create a visual or literary art piece conveying the contest's theme "Cultivating care and wonder by taking the bus to_____". Your art piece could seek to answer one or both of the following questions: what exciting places would you go to on the bus? or, if you could send a message of compassion and care to riders and drivers, what would it be?

Judging: Pierce Transit's Diversity, Equity and Inclusion committee will judge each submission based on creativity, technique, clarity of theme and connection to public transportation. The winning submissions will be displayed on Pierce Transit bus shelters and on PierceTransit.org.
