

Title: Interim Digital Organizer

The Washington Low Income Housing Alliance is seeking a Digital Organizer to help mobilize advocates during the 2021 legislative session. The position will start as soon as possible and last through April 2021. The position is fully remote.

Responsibilities:

- Write and send eblasts, online petitions, and sign-on letters
- Develop content for social media
- Write advocacy related blog posts and other advocacy content
- Collect and disseminate video stories and testimony
- Assist with targeted mobilization efforts in key legislative districts
- Update online bill tracker weekly
- Attend weekly advocacy team meetings (Fridays at noon) and biweekly advocate meetings (every other Friday from 1 to 2:15)

Pay and benefits: 20 hours per week. \$35 per hour. As a temporary, part-time role, this position will not offer benefits beyond paid sick and safe leave.
