1. Locate the UPS drop box closest to you at ups.com/dropoff.

2. Register your EverlyWell Test kit at everlywell.com/register.

3. Learn how to collect your sample by reading the instructions in the box and watching the **EverlyWell collection video** on the registration webpage.

4. Collect your sample and place in pre-paid shipping package. It is important to collect your sample AND send it via UPS on the SAME DAY. Samples can only be shipped Monday – Friday.



When to test for COVID-19?

Test if you have symptoms. It is recommended you test when you have symptoms even if you have been vaccinated. COVID-19 symptoms can be mistaken as allergies or the common cold.

Test if you have been around someone with COVID-19. It is best to get tested at least 5 days after the last potential exposure.

If you have not been vaccinated, test before and after attending an event, gathering or travelling.
