



Washington Families Clean Energy Credits

August 2024

- During the 2024 Legislative Session, the State appropriated \$150 million for the Washington Families Clean Energy Grant Program. This funding comes from the Climate Commitment Act (CCA).
- This program provides qualifying utility customers with a one-time, \$200 bill credit to help with energy costs. These credits will be applied until funding runs out.
- Tacoma Power was awarded approximately \$7.4 million, to be credited to qualifying customer accounts by Sept. 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
- Tacoma Power customers can learn about and apply for the bill credit at <a href="http://www.MyTPU.org/CCACredit">www.MyTPU.org/CCACredit</a>. This application must be filled out and signed no later than September 2, 2024.
- The CCA supports Washington's climate action efforts by putting cap-and-invest dollars to work reducing climate pollution, creating jobs, and improving public health. Information about the CCA is available at climate.wa.gov.
- Bill credits are available to customers whose annual income does not exceed 150 percent of the area median income, as listed below:

Household Size	150% Annual Median Income
1 person	up to \$121,600
2 people	up to \$138,950
3 people	up to \$156,350
4 people	up to \$173,700
5 people	up to \$187,600
6 people	up to \$201,500

- TPU is rolling out a social media campaign to promote the credit. Information will also be included in our August 2024 residential email newsletter that deploys on 8/15.
- There are currently 16,663 TPU power accounts that have been identified as eligible.





- If a customer is already enrolled in the Bill Credit Assistance Plan (BCAP) or the Discount Rate Program or has received Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) assistance since 2023, they **DO NOT** need to complete a self-attestation form. Their account will automatically have the grant applied.
- To facilitate enrollment of the customers who need it most first, TPU is working with a WA Department of Commerce contractor, Promise, to cross reference any TPU customers who are enrolled in state assistance programs. These customers will automatically qualify and be credited the \$200 bill credit.
