Warming centers and pop-up cold weather sites



NEW - Family Promise will host a warming center from 8pm to 8am tonight at their intake center in Parkland at 214 121st St. South. The warming center can host up to 30 people.

NEW - Common Good Tacoma will host an overnight shelter from 7pm to 7am tonight and on Wednesday this week at 621 Tacoma Ave. South. Capacity is 12 people. Pets are allowed.

- Day Centers can be used as warming sites during cold weather. You can find information about Day Centers on the Coalition website (link from the page you reach with the QR code above).
- Tacoma Public Libraries are open Tuesdays through Saturdays. NOTE: The main branch is currently closed for remodeling; it will reopen to the public on Saturday, Feb. 1 at 10 a.m.
- Pierce County Public Libraries are open Mondays through Saturdays, with most large branches also open on Sundays.
- Publicly available options to stay warm include making a visit to a mall during business hours.
- South Hill Mall is open and could be visited as a warming space, Monday Saturday from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m., and Sunday from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Tacoma:

- Catholic Community Services (Nativity House at 702 S. 14th St.) opens additional inclement weather spaces during cold weather.
- Tacoma Rescue Mission (425 South Tacoma Way) will expand operations to provide additional inclement weather beds during cold weather.
- St. Vincent de Paul (4009 S. 56th St.) provides warming in its Community Resource Center on Mon., Wed., Fri., Sat., and Sun. from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Brotherhood RISE (2136 Martin Luther King Jr. Way) will offer warming during business hours.
- Valeo Vocation is hosting a seasonal shelter (813 Martin Luther King Jr. Way) with space for up to 53 people on an ongoing basis through March 31, 2025. Access the site through a referral from the City of Tacoma's HEAL Team, the Shelter Access Hub, or a paid outreach team.
