Join our community feedback session for the State 5-Year Housing and Homeless Plan, an important update to the Comprehensive Plan to End Homelessness (CPEH).

Human Services, in collaboration with the community and partners, will modify the CPEH to ensure it addresses local housing and homeless needs in Pierce County for the next five years. Hear from Pierce County leadership, including Executive Ryan Mello, about these critical issues.

This in-person feedback session is the first in a series currently being scheduled, and future sessions will feature a virtual option. Guests who are unable to attend can submit their feedback one week before and after the event at PierceCountyWA.gov/homelessplan.

The updated plan must meet the following requirements:

- 1 Promote an equitable, accountable, and transparent homeless crisis response system.
- 2 Strengthen the homeless service provider workforce.
- 3 Prevent homeless episodes whenever possible.
- 4 Focus on those facing the greatest barriers to housing stability and highest risk of harm.
- 5 Seek to house everyone in a stable setting that meets their needs.
