WHAT WE DO

Justice Project's Right to Counsel Team is appointed by the Court to represent low-income tenants who have received a Summons and Complaint for eviction and are facing a Show Cause hearing. If you receive a Summons and Complaint for Unlawful Detainer contact us ASAP. If you have a hearing already scheduled, go to the hearing so HJP can help you.

Justice Project's HELP (Homeless & Eviction Legal Prevention) Team can help with other types of notices from landlords and other issues affecting housing stability, including repairs, move-out and move-in issues, disputes, habitability, discrimination, past evictions, legal financial obligations -- and more.

FAMILY SAFETY - the Family Safety Project works with the Crystal Judson Family Justice Center and other Pierce County providers to assist survivors of domestic violence with family law and other legal issues.

VOLUNTEER LEGAL CLINICS - 30-minute legal advice clinics can provide help in many areas, including divorce, parenting plans, custody, child support, guardianship, bankruptcy, consumer issues, estate issues and general civil legal issues.

Clients who have a legal issue IN PIERCE COUNTY (regardless of residence), at or below 200% of the federal poverty level or receiving public benefits are eligible. All applications are screened for financial eligibility, conflicts and program capacity.
