JUNE 20TH

We're excited to announce the launch of the "Drive to Achieve - Mobile Success Hub" in Pierce County on Tuesday, June 20th. This project, funded by a consortium of local colleges and organizations, aims to provide financial aid support to adult residents throughout the county. Housed in a converted RV, the mobile hub features up to 10 indoor workstations and 10 outdoor workstations, offering direct services from MDC FAAS and EOC Education Advisors. The program focuses on assisting individuals with FAFSA and WASFA applications, empowering them to pursue their education and career goals.

The "Drive to Achieve - Mobile Success Hub" addresses service gaps and brings financial aid services directly to Pierce County communities. With a mobile approach, it reaches rural areas and those lacking access to resources and technology. Staffed by knowledgeable advisors, the RV provides personalized assistance throughout the financial aid process. Whether inside or utilizing the outdoor workstations, individuals can receive the support they need to navigate applications and work towards their educational aspirations. Join us as we break down barriers and empower all Pierce County residents to thrive in their educational journey.
