Event Description

Tacoma/Pierce County Habitat for Humanity is partnering with The National Ready Mixed Concrete Association's (NRMCA) Build with Strength Coalition to construct three new, affordable, low carbon homes in Gig Harbor, WA utilizing insulated concrete forms (ICFs), a sustainable, noncombustible building system that reduces upfront construction expenses while maximizing the structure's durability and energy performance, saving homeowners long-term costs in utilities and insurance.

Community members, volunteers, local leaders and media are invited to a "Behind the Build" event September 21st, from 10 AM – 2 PM at Tacoma/Pierce County Habitat for Humanity's Canterwood site in Gig Harbor to celebrate the progress made and meet the many people and partners who have helped bring these homes to life.

Seeking to put God's love into action, Tacoma/Pierce County Habitat for Humanity partners with people to achieve and preserve homeownership, and to build generational wealth, hope, and opportunity. We have been constructing, rehabbing, and repairing homes in the community since 1985, serving income-qualified households who may otherwise be compressed out of the housing market.
