- VMFH Grant Brenda Mbaabu
 - 1st year VMFH offered funding opportunity. Offered by Common Spirit in the past.
 - Opportunity for CBOs and hospitals to help improve health in community and quality of life.
 - Criteria includes: orgs addressing 1 or more prioritized needs; seeking to work with orgs to improve access to health care, chronic disease prevention, access to quality health care, violence prevention, working with vulnerable or underserved. Working as a collaboration between 2 or more partners who are doing distinct or complementary work. E.g. one org assisting immigrants in getting health insurance and also another org providing translation/interpretation services.
 - Preference given to those working with VMFH hospital, but not a requirement.
 - 501(c)3 org, school, or government agency. If you are not a 501(c)3 you can work with a fiscal agent.
 - Funding awarded to projects in the range of \$20,000-\$100,000.
 - Hope grant will be implemented during 2024. Pilot year. Unclear if there will be future funding. Projects for 1 year during 2024.
 - Mid-year and final report required.
 - o Recorded information session from Aug. 1 available.
 - Also looking for orgs working with the spectrum of prevention.
 - Grant eligibility and timeline.
 - July 17-Sept 8, 2023 applications accepted. Grantees notified by Nov. 15, 2023.
 Jan 1- December 31, 2024 project period.

- General operating expenses, sponsorships or less than 9 months are ineligible projects. Also, no political, lobbying projects. No indirect costs I.e. legal services, administrative fees, etc.
