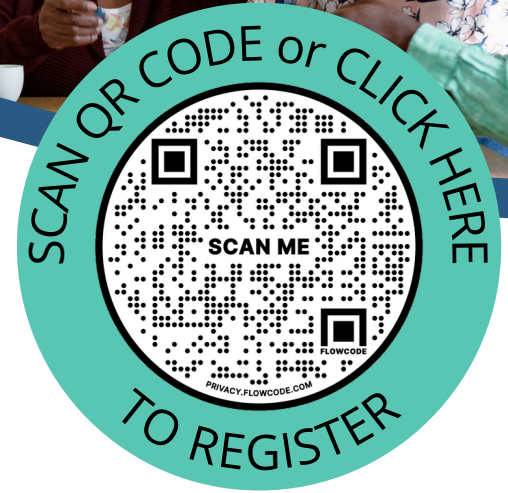




Join our interactive discussions on healthy aging in Pierce County!
