- Norma Pancake – if you come across someone with this, but not severe enough what do you do?
 - Kenneth – we supply them with multiple pairs of dry socks
 - Tammy – shoes is a big factor, that has to be dry as well

Foot Care Clinic?

- Norma – Would this be something beneficial to have? Isiah, is that something TPCHD can do?
- Isiah – I can ask, I know they have done footcare info in the past, but I will ask if its possible.
- Kenneth – even if its informational I think it would be very beneficial, any sort of pamphlets on the subject would be beneficial
- Isiah – the cards we passed out did had info on trench foot, but for something a bit more extensive, I will ask internally.
- Tammy – What about a footcare pack? We also have a nurse that comes in and checks everyone's feet weekly
