  - Caleb Carbone – per their contract they have resources they can buy them it might be a supply issue.
  - Caleb Carbone – the ones we got for the Brotherhood Rise shelter, takes quite a bit of lead time, ordered them in December but not expecting to receive them until March
  - Jaquan Satchel – Cots are not breaking because people being larger, the ones we got are made from aluminum, and they seem to bow under heat, the new ones we have do not seem to be having issues
    - Caleb – those must be the new steel cots, we will work to get more of those.
