ORDINANCE NO. 28756

BY REQUEST OF MAYOR WOODARDS, DEPUTY MAYOR BLOCKER, AND 1 COUNCIL MEMBER THOMS 2 AN ORDINANCE relating to public health and safety; amending Title 8 of the 3 Tacoma Municipal Code by enacting a new Chapter 8.19 thereto, to be known and designated as "Use of Public Property"; and providing for 4 severability. 5 WHEREAS the Tacoma City Charter grants the City Council the authority to 6 exercise the police power of the City established pursuant to Article XI, Section 11 7 8 of the State Constitution, to preserve the public peace, health, and safety, and to 9 regulate public property within the City, and 10 WHEREAS it is the intent of this ordinance to provide for and promote the 11 health, safety, and welfare of the general public and not to create, either expressly 12 or implicitly, or otherwise establish or designate any particular class or group of 13 14 persons or individuals who will or should be especially protected or benefited or 15 discriminated against by the terms of this chapter, and 16 WHEREAS it is the City Council's intent that camping on public property is a 17 public health and safety concern due to interference with other intended uses, such 18 as daily operations of the City; park recreational activities; pedestrian, bicycle, and 19 20 vehicular traffic; and other public uses, and 21 WHEREAS it is the City Council's intent that camping without adequate 22 sanitation services, such as sewer, water, and garbage, presents a public health 23 and safety concern due to increased risk of spread of disease and potential for 24 residents and visitors contracting illness, and 25 26

	WHEREAS it is the City Council's intent that this ordinance will provide for	
1	and promote the health, safety, and welfare of the general public and not to create,

9 10	WHEREAS camping in such public property areas does not allow the public	
10	to use those areas for their intended purposes, and	
12	WHEREAS it is the City Council's intent that this ordinance will provide that	
13	camping should only occur in designated campgrounds with proper facilities, when	
14	possible, and	
15	WHEREAS the homeless population in the Puget Sound region continues to	
16 17	grow, and the City has experienced increasing use of its parks and public spaces	
18	property for camping and the storage of personal property, and	
19	WHEREAS, pursuant to <i>Martin v. City of Boise</i> , 920 F.3d 584 (9th Cir. 2019),	
20		
21	prohibits the imposition of penalties for sitting, sleeping, or lying outside on public	
22 23	property, on homeless individuals who could not obtain shelter, and	
23	WHEREAS the City Council hereby finds that the regulatory requirements	
25	established by the proposed ordinance are necessary to preserve the public peace,	
26	health, safety, and welfare; Now, Therefore,	



BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TACOMA:

1	Section 1. That Title 8 of the Tacoma Municipal Code is hereby amended
2	by the addition of a new Chapter 8.19 thereto, to be known and designated as
3	"Use of Public Property," to read as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A."
4	Section 2. If any provision of this ordinance of its application to any person
5	
6	or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance or the application
7	of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.

"Camp Facilities" means, without limitation, tents, huts, and temporary shelters. 7 "Camp Paraphernalia" means, without limitation, blankets, pillows, tarpaulins, cots, beds or bedding, sleeping 8 bags, hammocks, non-City designated cooking facilities, and/or other similar equipment. "City" means the City of Tacoma, Washington, the area within the territorial limits of the City. 9 "Pier" means any pier, wharf, dock, float, gridiron, or other structure where watercraft may anchor or moor. 10 "Public Property" means all property in which the City or any other governmental entity has a property interest, including easements. The term includes, without limitation, all parks, Piers, Streets, trails, forests, 11 park museums, pools, beaches, open spaces, public squares, public schools and associated athletic facilities, grounds around City or other publicly owned or leased buildings, including, but not limited to, parking lots, 12 and any other property in which the City or any other governmental entity has a property interest of any type. 13 "Store" means to put aside, accumulate, or leave on Public Property for later use, or for safekeeping. "Street" means, without limitation, any easements, highway, lane, road, street, right-of-way, boulevard, alley, 14 and all Public Property open as a matter of right to public vehicle travel or parking. 15 8.19.030 Unauthorized Use Of Public Property. Unless otherwise permitted by the Tacoma Municipal Code, it shall be unlawful for any person to Camp 16 within any Public Property. 17 8.19.040 Unauthorized Storage Of Personal Property On Public Property. It shall be unlawful for any person to Store personal property, including, without limitation, Camp Facilities 18 and Camp Paraphernalia, on any Public Property. 19 8.19.050 Penalty For Violations. Violation of Section 8.19.030 or Section 8.19.040 of this Chapter is a misdemeanor offense and shall be 20 punished upon conviction of such violation by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment not to exceed 90 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. 21 A. First and second violations of Section 8.19.030 or Section 8.19.040 of this Chapter are a class 4 civil 22 infraction, pursuant to RCW 7.80.120, subject to a penalty of \$25, not including statutory assessments.
